PGA: Transport Canada Program: Tires

The Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) assists **Transport Canada (TC)** with the administration of the **Motor Vehicle Safety Act** and the **Motor Vehicle Tire Safety Regulations**.

The following information is required for the importation of tires for new on-road passenger vehicles, trucks, motorcycle, trailer or multi-purpose vehicles; and used truck tires imported for retreading from countries other than the United States:

- Manufactures name
- Name, telephone number, postal code and email address of the company
- Brand name
- Tire type/size and the quantity of tires of that size designation and type imported
- Tire compliance indicator
- Import reason code

Implementation of the CBSA Single Window Initiative (SWI)

Under the Single Window Initiative, release requests will be submitted utilizing a new Integrated Import Declaration (IID) that allows custom brokers to submit and obtain electronic release for goods also regulated by participating department and agencies. Release requests for tires may be provided to the CBSA electronically by submitting an IID.

Note: The information required under the SWI does not add any additional requirements, which currently exist to the import process.

"I [declare]/[have been authorized by the company referred to in this form to declare, on their behalf.] that the tires referred to in this form conforms to the standards prescribed for a tire of that class by section 3 to 5 of the Motor Vehicle Tire Safety Regulations at the time the tire was manufactured."
